

Diplomates with a Certification Cycle that Ends in 2027

- Answer 60 ABPerio Minute questions in 2025.
 15 questions per quarter
- Answer 60 ABPerio Minute questions in 2026.
 15 questions per quarter
- Answer 60 ABPerio Minute questions in 2027.
 15 questions per quarter
- Attest to the completion of 60 CE activity points from January 2022 through December 31, 2027.
- Attestation that all licenses are in good standing with all applicable regulatory agencies.



As a reminder, all Diplomates **must register** with the ABP annually and pay the required registration fee.



You cannot work ahead on your quarterly ABPerio Minute requirements, **but you can make up questions during the year.** Diplomates may not answer more than 15 questions in a day.



This is **not intended to be an exam** and your performance in ABPerio Minute is not graded. ABPerio Minute is provided for individual self-assessment. The goal is to provide ongoing learning opportunities utilizing effective adult learning techniques.



This is not intended to be a punitive process. The ABP hopes that you will quickly adapt to ABPerio Minute and integrate it into your daily activities. We understand, though, that it will take time to adjust your routine to incorporate this new requirement. **The ABP is primarily focused on your engagement with the platform.** If you are having trouble meeting the yearly ABPerio Minute requirements during this initial rollout phase, the ABP will work with you to ensure your compliance.

A FEW REMINDERS FOR ALL DIPLOMATES:

There is no fee for continuing certification.

Diplomates who do not activate their ABPerio Minute account by December 31, 2025, will be placed on inactive status.

Diplomates who are on inactive status for failure to meet annual registration requirements will not be eligible to participate in ABPerio Minute.

Diplomates who wish to return from inactive status will be required to take a 360-question exam, pay a \$500 exam registration fee, a \$100 late fee, and a \$75 reactivation fee. In addition, the Diplomate will be required to pay any past due annual registration fees and late fees. Once reactivated, the Diplomate will be required to meet all ABPerio Minute yearly requirements for the remainder of the Diplomate's certification cycle.

Diplomates may request, in writing, a waiver of yearly requirements based on approved situations (e.g. military status, medical disability).
